Over the last ten years I have visited many high schools and middle schools. I do these visits for free if the students have read one my books. My YA novel, *What Happened*, has been used at LaSalle Academy, Bishop Feehan, Bishop Connolly, and Tolman High School, to mention a few. My middle-grade novel, *The Amazing Adventures of John Smith Jr, aka Houdini* (which is in paperback) has also been read widely at such schools as Tiverton Middle School (an all-book read), North Dartmouth Middle School, Curtis Corner Middle School, Friends Academy, Henry Barnard School, St. Michael's in Fall River, St. Andrews, and Rye Neck Middle School in Rye Neck, NY.
